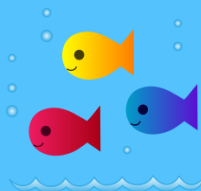

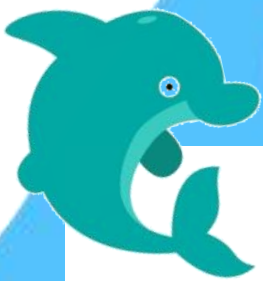
PARSHIOS MATOS-MASSEI

Recipe Page:

Sugar cookies:

Ingredients-

2 $\frac{3}{4}$ cup all purpose flour

1 tsp baking soda

$\frac{1}{2}$ tsp baking powder

1 cup butter softened

1 $\frac{1}{2}$ cups white sugar 1 egg

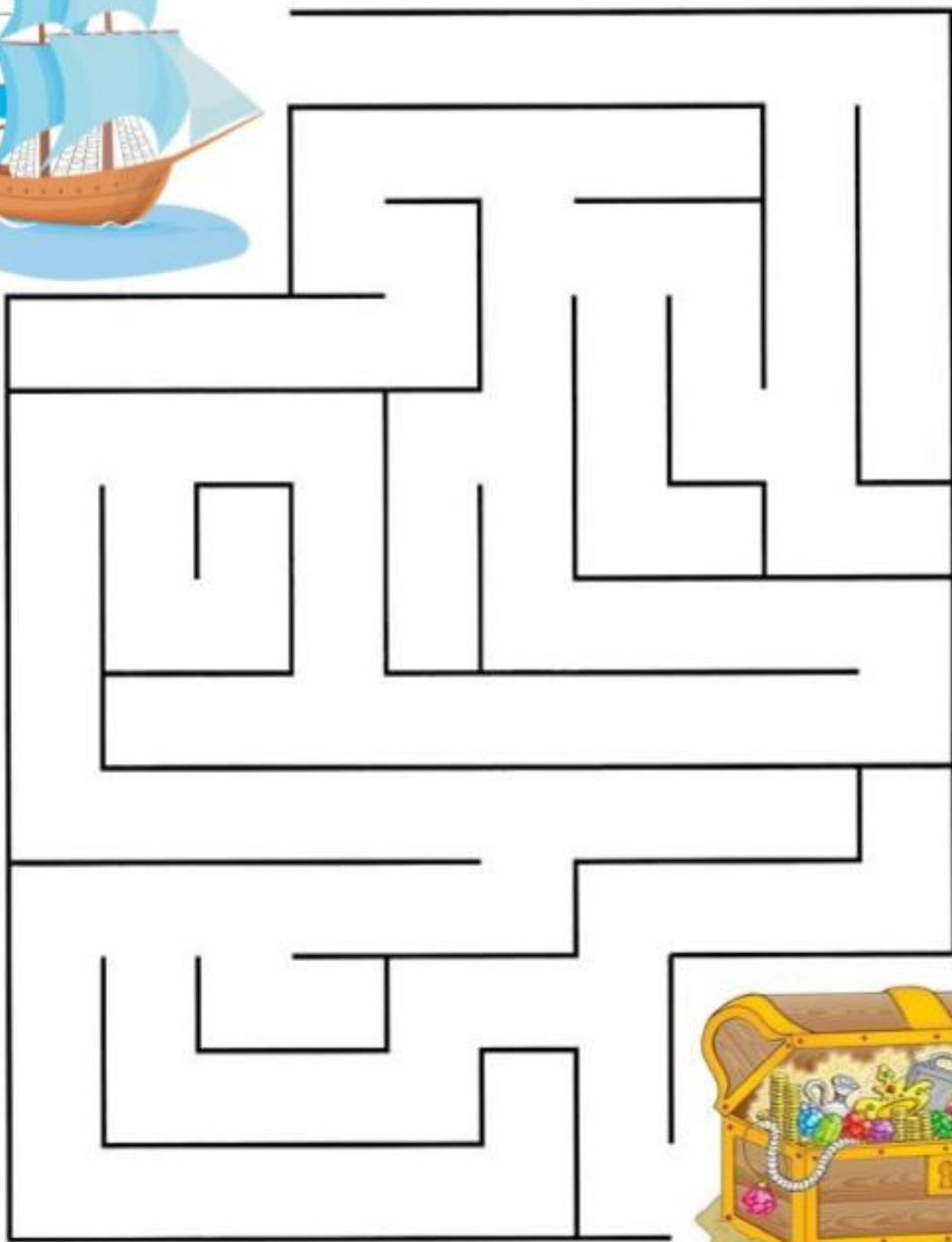
1 tsp vanilla extract

Instructions:

- 1. Preheat oven to 375 degrees F (190 degrees C). In a small bowl, stir together flour, baking soda, and baking powder. Set aside**
- 2. In a large bowl, cream together sugar and butter until smooth. Beat in egg and vanilla. Gradually blend in the dry ingredients. Roll rounded teaspoonfuls of dough into balls, and place onto ungreased cookie sheets.**
- 3. Bake 8-10 minutes in the preheated oven, or until golden. Let stand on cookie sheet two minutes before removing to cool on wire racks.**
